Instructions for Completing a Petition for Credit for Articulated Courses

1. Earn a grade of "B" or better in a high school CTE/ROP or Adult Education course that is articulated with Coastline College. *
2. Apply to Coastline College at coastline.edu/admissions-and-records.
3. Obtain a copy of your high school CTE/ROP or Adult Education transcript.
4. Complete and sign the student section of a [Petition for Credit for Articulated Courses](#).
5. Submit the Petition and your transcripts to the Coastline CTE Department at cte@coastline.edu.

* Please note that articulation for an approved course will be honored up to five (5) years from the date of completion of the CTE, ROP, or Adult Education course.

Once your Petition has been reviewed and approved by Coastline's CTE Department, it will be submitted for processing and the units will be posted to your Coastline transcript.
