Procedure

- 1. Outside class assignments shall be relevant to the course and challenging to the student.
- 2. Assignments may include, but are not limited to the following:
 - a. Interviewing a person employed in a field related to the course.
 - b. Touring a business related to the course.
 - c. Researching a specific facet of a field related to the course.
- 3. Assignments should emphasize quality rather than quantity.
- 4. Evaluation of completed outside class assignments may be included in the determination of grades earned.
- 5. Hours of attendance for credit or apportionment purposes may not be increased as a result of the completion of such assignments, except to make up for the loss of credit hours as a result of approve absences.
