Administrative Regulation

Students

ROP staff shall intervene whenever students use alcohol or other illegal drugs while at ROP facilities, school property, or under ROP jurisdiction. Staff members who believe that a student may be under the influence of alcohol or drugs shall immediately notify the instructional administrator.

If the instructional administrator or designee knows, observes or suspects that a student may be under the influence of alcohol or drugs, he/she shall notify the parent/guardian (Education Code 44049).

In cases of medical emergency, the instructional administrator or designee is authorized to call an ambulance to remove the student to a hospital. Parents/guardians shall be notified of this action and shall be responsible for the incurred expenses.

Staff shall notify the instructional administrator or designee immediately upon suspecting that a student is selling, providing, or use alcohol or other drugs.

When any student uses, possesses, or sells alcohol or illegal drugs at ROP facilities or while under ROP jurisdiction, the following shall result:

- 1. Parent/guardian and student support services shall be contacted for minor students
- 2. Students shall be suspended or expelled in accordance with law, or
- 3. Contact with law enforcement authority shall be enacted within one school day of the suspension.
