Board Bylaws

The Governing Board recognizes the complex legal environment in which the Program operates and desires reliable, dependable, legal advice. The Board also supports collaborative legal efforts with other ROP's, districts, and other agencies, in order to promote the ROP's interests.

The Board may use the county counsel, district attorney, or private attorneys to meet the needs of the ROP.

The ROP's legal counsel may:

1. Render legal advice to the Board and the Superintendent or designee.
2. Serve the Board and the Superintendent or designee in the preparation and conduct of ROP litigation and administrative proceedings.
3. Perform other responsibilities as assigned by the Board or the Superintendent or designee.

The Superintendent may confer with the ROP's legal counsel at his/her discretion and shall provide the Board with desired legal information when needed.
