## **Policy**

## **Community Relations**

An Advisory Committee shall be established for each occupational training area of the ROP. The purpose of these committees is to advise on current job market standards and needs, review and validate curriculum content, identify equipment and technology needs, review the appropriateness of training facilities, and assist planners and instructors in making each course of instruction relevant to the employment training needs of the community.

Each committee shall be composed of at least five representatives currently working in the businesses and industries that typically employ people in the field of training. Instructors of courses in the occupational training area shall serve as ex officio members of the committees and may be involved in the committee meetings. At least one meeting will be held each year in each occupational training area.

Committee representation and activities shall be in compliance with the California Education Code and the California State Perkins Plan.
