

SELECTION AND EVALUATION OF INSTRUCTIONAL MATERIALS BP 6161.1

Policy

The Governing Board desires that instructional materials, as a whole, present a broad spectrum of knowledge and viewpoints, reflect and value society's diversity, and enhance instructors' ability to educate all students through the use of multiple teaching strategies and technologies. The Board shall adopt instructional materials based on a determination that such materials are an effective learning resource to help students achieve Career Technical Education competency and academic standards. Textbooks, technology-based materials, and other educational materials shall effectively support and enhance the organization's adopted courses of study.

The Superintendent or designee shall develop procedures for determining the sufficiency of North Orange County Regional Occupational Program instructional materials in providing accurate, current information and ensuring that students have access to standards-based materials.

In selecting or adopting instructional materials, the Board shall consider the recommendation of the Superintendent or designee and/or an advisory committee established to review the materials.
